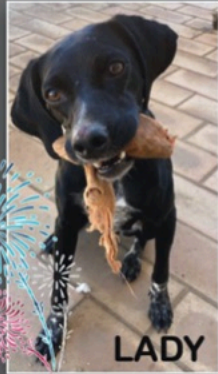

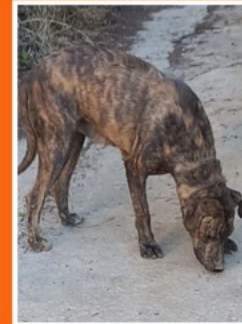
STREETLIFE HAS ACHIEVED 1000 STERILISATIONS!! ... LADY

Lady (about 2-years old) is StreetLife's 1000th sterilisation. We believe she was dumped from a car at the olive press in Santa Catarina. She stayed in the area, checking each car that came by, waiting for her owner.... nervous and stressed. Eve, a local independent animal rescuer and StreetLife supporter, tried in vain to trap her. After hearing that the municipal Vet was due to pick Lady up the next day, she gave it one last try and managed to catch her in a cage.

StreetLife was delighted to help with the sterilisation of Lady, who is now fostered with Eve. Along with the other rescue dogs, Lady is safe and being cared for. She is a beauty... check out the paw markings! Incredible...

Let's try and make this a double celebration for Lady... not only is she our 1000th sterilisation, she also needs a loving permanent home.

Lady is a hunting/scent dog and may have some spaniel/pointer in her - she needs some work but is looking for her forever home. It is imperative the right home is found for this very special Lady.

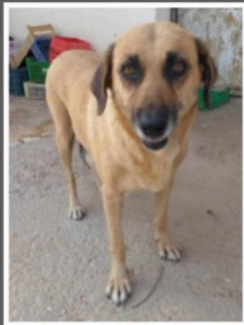


1001 - Daniela

We were happy to help and Marie and Adrian took care of the logistics again. Thank you!

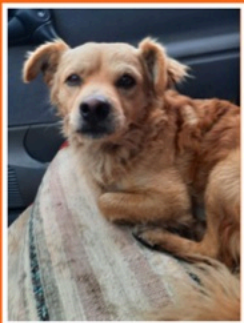


1004 - Safira

Hopefully Boneco is now a home-loving guy. 😊

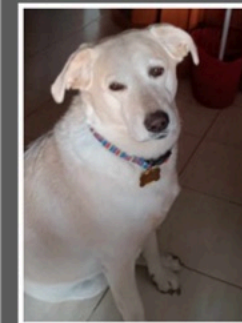


1006 - Grande

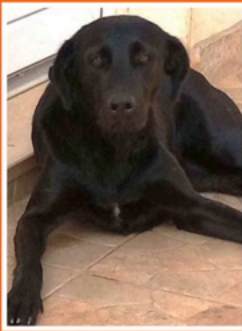

She found out about StreetLife and StreetEye Carla visited to take care of things.

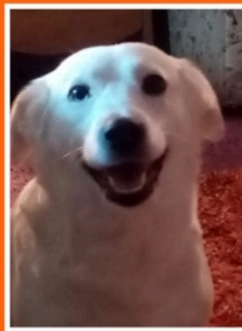


1008 - Tchenga

Now, everyone can live in peace. 😊

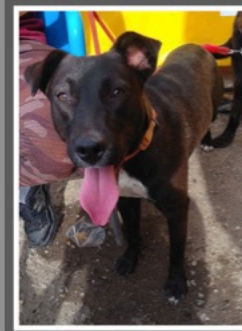


1009 - Lady

When one of the females – named Lady – came on heat, one of the males escaped and, well you know the rest ...!

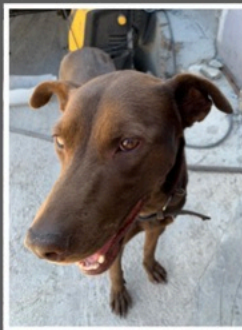
We managed to get Lady to the Vet in time and prevented even more unwanted puppies on the street.

Ricardo lives in the countryside in Altura and already had two adopted dogs. Little Bluey appeared at his house and he decided to keep her as well.

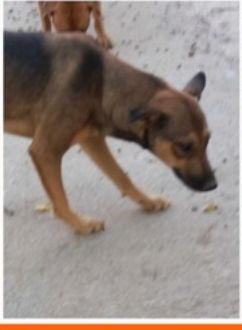

Valeriu from Olhão contacted us to get help with the sterilisation of little 4 year old Roma because the cost was too high.

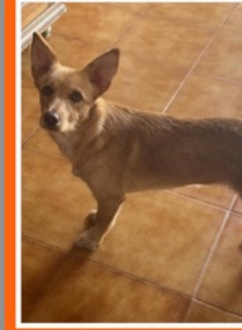
He offered to make a donation and we agreed to help – that's pretty much it! It's good to see someone who knows that sterilisation is the way to go!

It's been a something of a "journey"..... but the situation is sorted and we can all relax.... at least for now! 😊

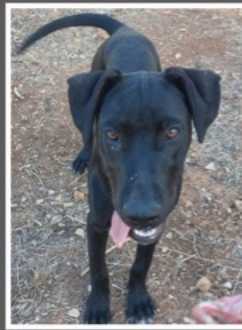


1013 - Sophia

We agreed with a small donation towards the costs, since the family was unemployed. 😊

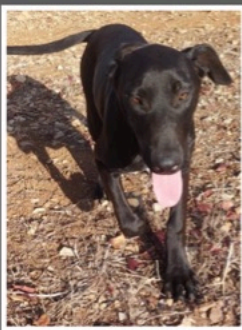


1014 - Milo

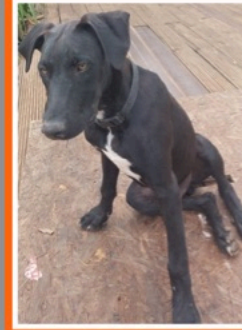

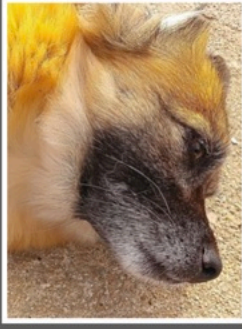


1017 - Marvin

This is Marvin and his brothers are Milo, Mayo and Magic.

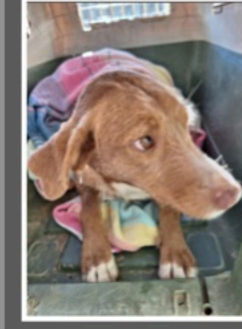


1018 - Lenny

StreetEye Carla visited and we agreed to help. Unfortunately, Lenny did not want to co-operate so this photo was the best Carla could do!

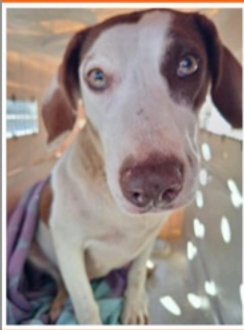


1019 - Priscilla

We were happy to oblige! 😊

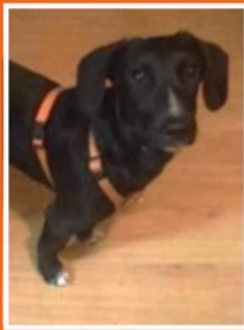


1020 - Perola

We agreed to help to prevent further problems.

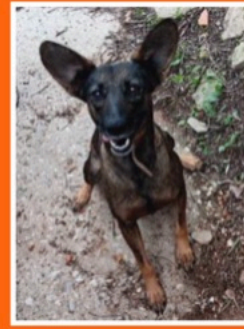


1023 - Borboleta

We agreed to help to prevent further problems.

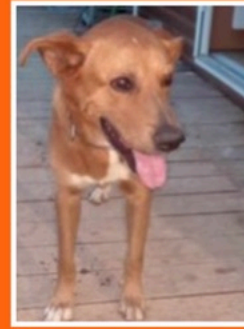


1024 - Ferrusca

She is last of the puppies that Marie and Adrian from "2ndhand4footers" have been looking to rehome. Happy to help as usual!

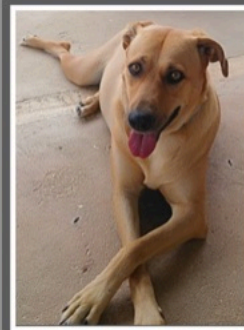


1025 - Simba

A good team effort!



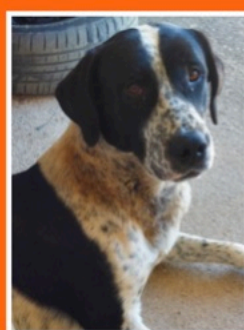
1027 - Fofinha

To avoid accidents, it was essential for Fofinha to be sterilised so StreetLife was contacted and we agreed to help.

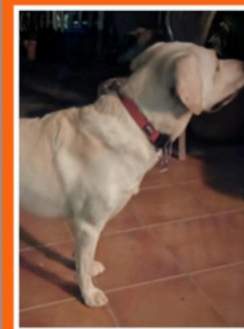
Job done!

Ana Maria wanted him to be snipped but just couldn't afford it, so we agreed to help.

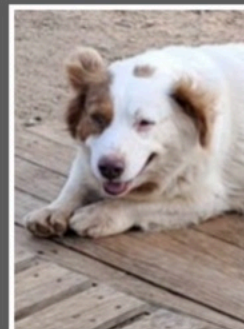


1030 - Nala

StreetEye Carla visited to see the situation and we agreed to help.

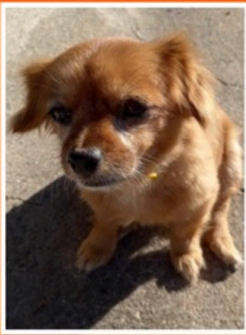


1031 - Sky

APAR told her about StreetLife and StreetEye Carla visited to see the situation.

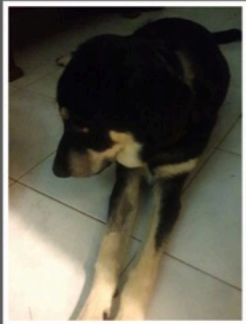
It was clear that Ana Paula needed help so we agreed.

StreetEye Dineke visited to see the situation and we finally managed to get Luna sorted.



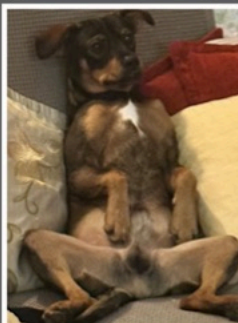
1041 - Homeless 2

Adrian got Homeless 2 a parmer Vet just in time! Homeless3 – was also caught and her photo will be posted soon.

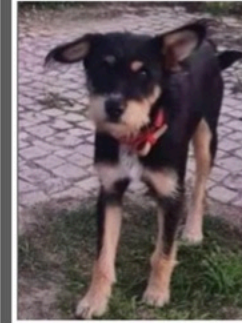
Well done team!

He runs around the farm and gets in the way of cars, so Tiara contacted us on behalf of Ana's family and asked if we could help with calming him down. We agreed!



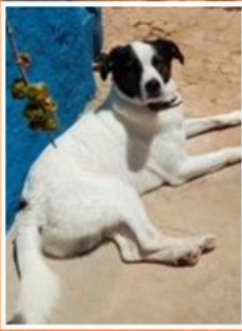
1043 - Bob

StreetLife was only too pleased to snip this little loveable rascal.



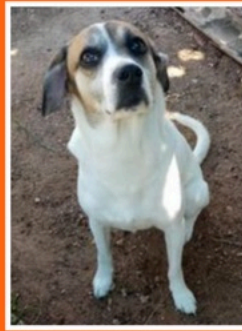


1044 - Zorrinho

StreetLife of course, was happy to agree to help.

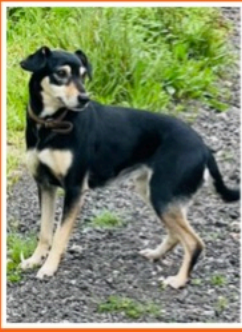

Brenda tries to help people with their animal problems and asked us sterilise little Serafina.

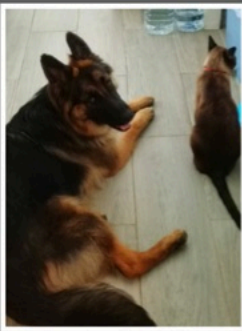
Her owner Luis, has some health issues and StreetLife was happy to help.

Patricia from Boliqueime is without work at the moment so asked us to help her with one-year old Raya.

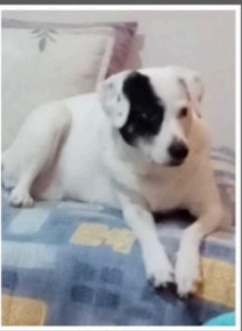
This is what StreetLife is all about.... and we were delighted to help!

Helder from Olhão asked us to help with 1-year old Lua who clearly doesn't have a problem with cats!

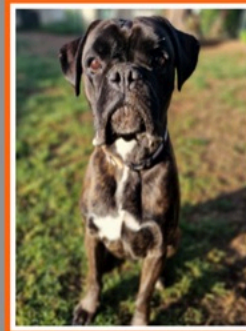
StreetLife was happy to help.

StreetLife is always here to support our StreetEyes and our Partner Shelters



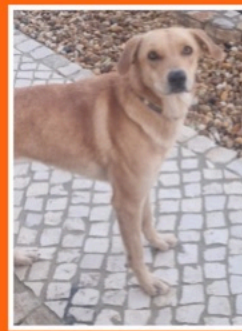
1052 - Monty

What an adorable face, he doesn't look like he could get into any trouble !!!

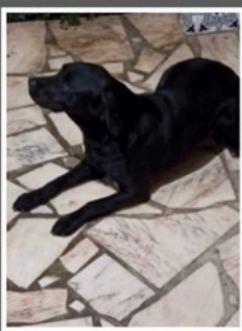

Nataliya from Loulé also took advantage of our February promotion to have 18-month old Bufy sterilised, before she became pregnant.

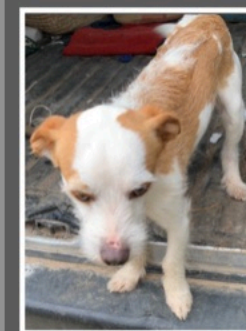

1055 - Buddy

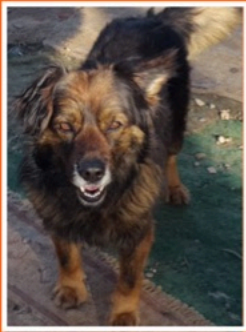
Meinhard was an early client of StreetLife and as he recently rescued the cute 2-year old Buddy, he asked us to help out again.

As you can guess.... StreetLife was only too pleased to help!



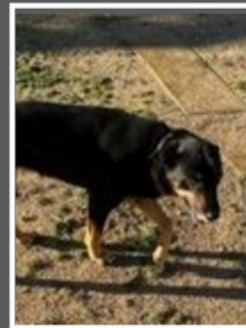
1058 - Fifi

The pack is now under control!

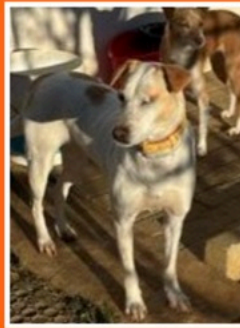


1059 - Tibi

The result.... NO unwanted puppies

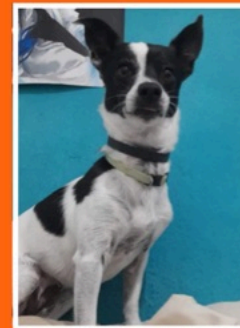


1060 - Branquinha

Sterilisation is the only way to reduce the number of unwanted puppies.

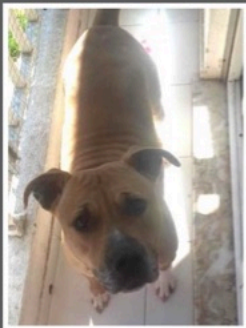


1061 - Mimi

Little Kira looks like she's frowning at the camera... clearly, she didn't want to smile!

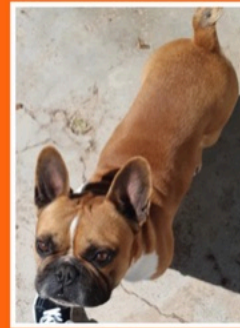


1063 - Estrelinha

Estrelinha can now run around with her tail wagging and not worry about getting pregnant!

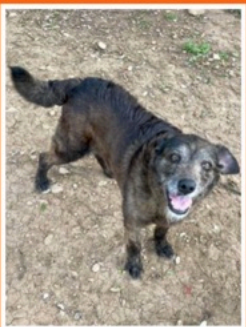


1064 - Spike

His owner, Ana saw one of our posters at the Junta's office in Moncarapacho and completed a form, asking for help.

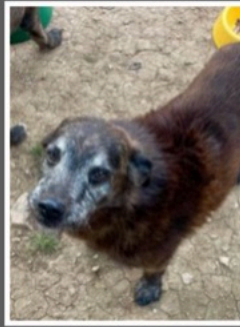
Within days little Spike was snipped and now can't cause any trouble with the ladies!

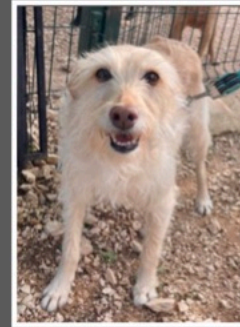

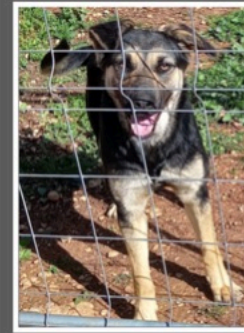

StreetLife was happy to help... thank you to Dineke, our StreetEye for sorting everything out on our behalf. 😊

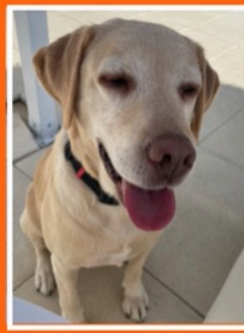


1071 - Coca

Gabriela doesn't have to worry about Kaly getting pregnant!

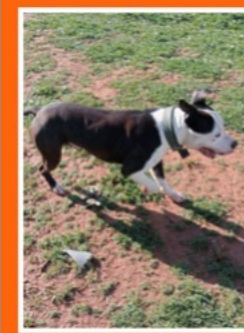


1075 - Rex

StreetEye Dineke went to visit Rex and recommended we help the family... now the surrounding females are safe from his "attentions".



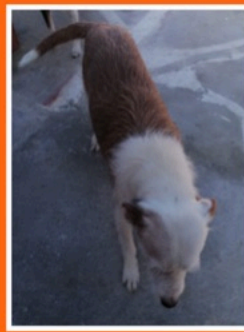
1076 - Zeus

At least he will be able to play with the ladies and not cause any problems now!

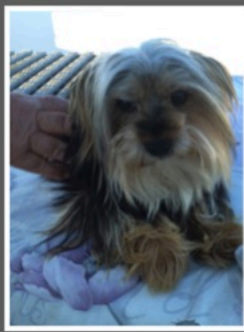


1077 - King

StreetLife was so pleased to help with the sterilisation. Have a happy life little one, you deserve it!

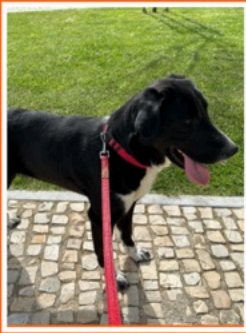


1079 - Bia

We assessed the situation and authorised the application. Another successful sterilisation!

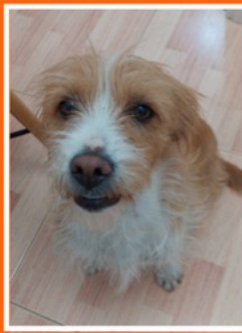


1080 - Laika

They asked for support from StreetLife and we were only too pleased to help.

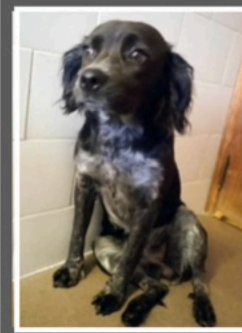


1081 - Estrelinha

Trigor now has a new life and a new home with Ana!

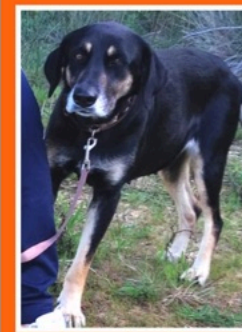


1084 - Menina

We were only too pleased to help. Have a good life Otelinda and lots of waggy tail moments!

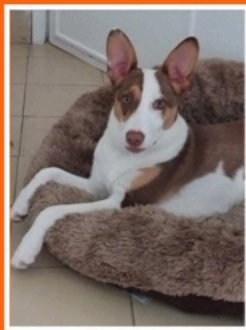


1084 - Menina

We were only too pleased to help. Have a good life Otelinda and lots of waggy tail moments!

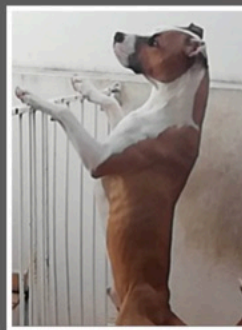


1085 - Luna

Now Arlete doesn't have to worry about Luna getting pregnant and Luna can have a tail wagging life!

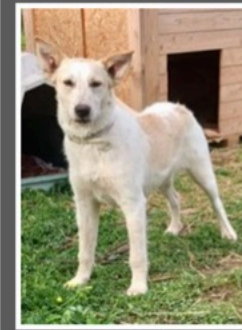


1086 - Vlad

StreetLife was very happy to help. Now Molly is safe... no pregnancies!

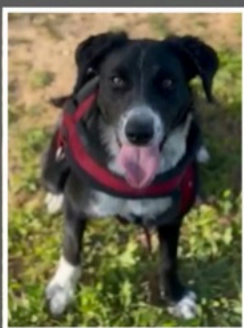


1093 - Dizzy

Maria found out about StreetLife from the local Junta.

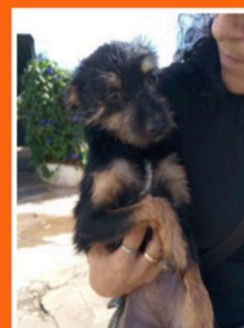
We went to visit and we very happy to agree to help!

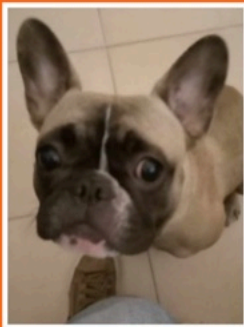


1096 - Esperança

Anabela is still trying to pay Vet bills, so StreetLife was thrilled to help.



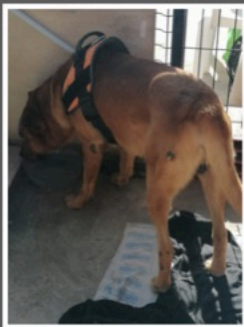
1097 - Pipoca

We will never understand why people neglect their dogs?

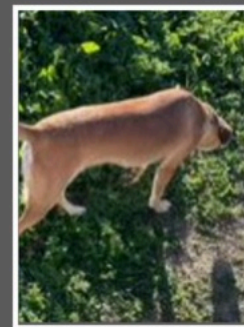


1098 - Ziggy

Well done Tiago! You are doing a great job!

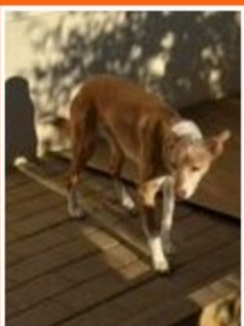


1099 - Luna
