These are the dogs that StreetLife has sterilised - No 700 to 800. We could not do this without our supporters. Working together, we can reduce the number of unwanted puppies and stray dogs in the East Algarve.

Pantufa 733




Luis visited us at an art fair earlier in the year and we helped him with Pipoca (No 671).

Preta 756




This is Preta who showed up at Rosália's mother's house. She was there for days and with no microchip or anybody searching for her, she stayed.

This is exactly the kind of behaviour that creates the problems we're facing!


769 Cálita

After several months on the street, injured and possibly pregnant, Mulan's days of suffering are over.


APAR finally managed to capture this little girlie and asked StreetLife if we would help with her sterilisation.
