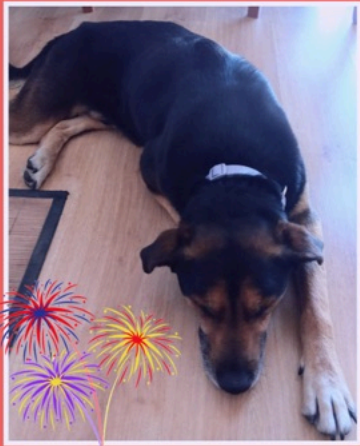

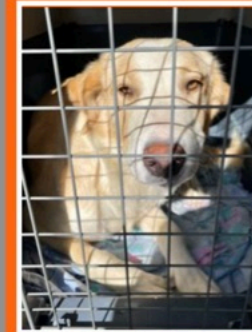
Sterilisation No 900 - 23 June 2023

So here is Udon who is about 4 years old. He had been wandering around Loulé for a while and was spotted by Catarina and her family. Sadly, he was in a bit of a state – very skinny and covered in ticks etc! They cleaned him up and took him to the Vet to scan for a microchip (none of course) and for a general check. After deciding to keep him, they sought help to have him snipped at the suggestion of their Vet (one of our partners).

StreetEye Dineke went to visit and suggested that he should also have a couple of additional blood tests, which proved positive for leish and tick fever, but (fortunately) it wasn't too serious.

So, after a course of medication, he went for his snip and is now a happy dog in his new home!

Great teamwork all round! 😊

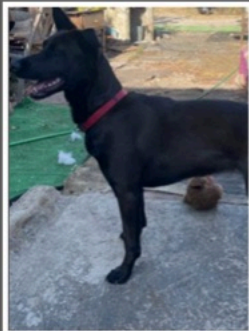


901 - Ursa

Here we have little 2 year old Ursa on the way to the Vet.

She belongs to Antonio in Quelfes and StreetEye Roseane helped with the paperwork and transport.

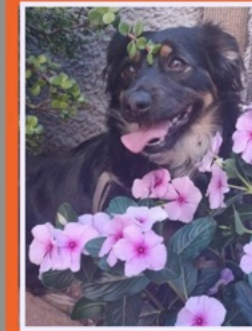
StreetEye Carla went to visit them all in Santa Catarina Fonte do Bispo and we agreed to help. Another successful result!

StreetEye Carla went to see them and we agreed to help. We love the ears!!

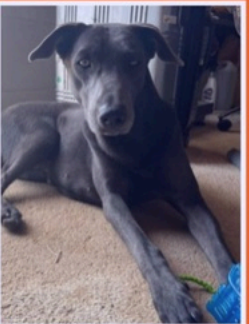


904 - Lua

However, she is another girl who likes to get out and about when she is on heat! Maria looked around for help with sterilisation and was directed to StreetLife.

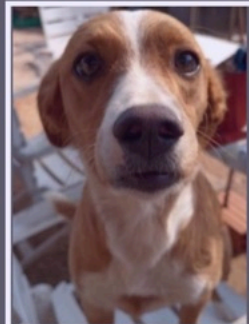
Everything taken care of now! 😊

André loves animals but health problems forced him and Emily to move back in with his mother who also has several dogs and cats, including two unsterilised male dogs.

Most of the animals come from shelters or bad situations, so we agreed to help sterilise Emily with a donation from André.

Carlos lives near Moncarapacho with his elderly grandfather and is unable to work after a recent accident. They have two little ladies – Ritinha and Betty Boop (No 907) – and went to the Junta da Freguesia's office to enquire about sterilisation because they had seen StreetLife posters in the area.

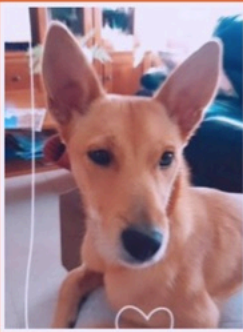
Where they live is all open so the dogs roam and Ritinha became pregnant (unsurprisingly). But now they've been sorted out and there should not be any further problems.

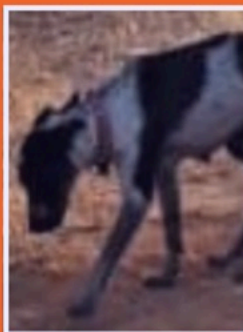
Where they live is all open so the dogs roam and Ritinha became pregnant (unsurprisingly). But now they've been sorted out and there should not be any further problems.

Aurea was adopted as a baby at APAR. She is a young, little dog energetic and very playful. Owner Vera goes for a walk with her in a nearby field, but she's afraid that when Aurea goes on heat there's a risk that she could become pregnant because there are males around.

Unfortunately, Vera is unemployed and couldn't afford the full cost of sterilisation. APAR told her to request support from Streetlife. StreetEye Carla visited and we agreed to help. 😊



909 - Kiche

Our good friend Célia at ADAPO asked if we could help out with a situation she had come across. Kiche had just had puppies and owner Custodio didn't know what to do; we agreed to get her sterilized to prevent the same thing happening again.

Sorry about the poor photo – it was taken from a distance on their open ground because Kiche is still very protective of the pups.



910 - Triolua

Tiago "inherited" 6 year old Triolua from his uncle and thought that she was already sterilised.

When she went on heat he realised that this was not the case so he spoke to his Vet in Tavira (one of our partners) who told him about StreetLife.

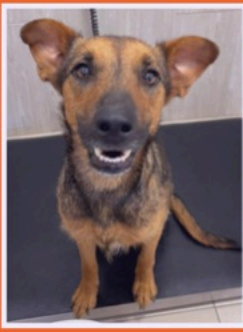
He made an application for help to which we agreed and so when her heat was finished we got Triolua to the Vet and all is good. 😊

This is 4 year old Baunilha who belongs to Antonio from Quelfes.

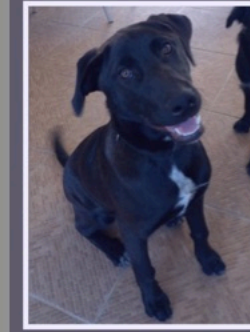
StreetEye Roseane asked if we could help out with this situation and we agreed. 😊

StreetEye Roseane visited to check for a microchip (none of course) and bought some antibiotics because Bruna had tick fever. After her health improved, Bruna went for her surgery and all is now well.



914 - Cacau

This is Cacau, sister of Xini and Belle (No 895 and No 896). was found with her sisters alone on the side of the road. Maria kept Cacau and her daughter Cristina kept the other two. Cacau is a bit naughty but in a good way - she ruins the pots and the plants, but at the same time she is very sweet.

Maria asked if we could help with calming her down a bit and StreetEye Carla took care of things ... with a donation from Maria. 😊



915 - Luffy

Another of Lidia's "pack" being sorted out by StreetEye Dineke (the first was Nami, No 912).

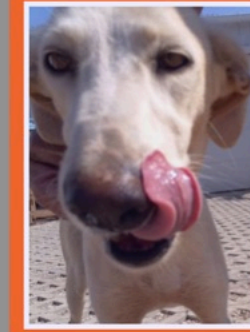
This the second one – Luffy, who is also about 8 months old. 😊

Pipoca sometimes escapes and goes after the neighbours' chickens. She is 9 months old now and became pregnant with Jorge's male dog. Jorge found homes for the babies but did not want a repeat performance, so he was advised to contact StreetLife.

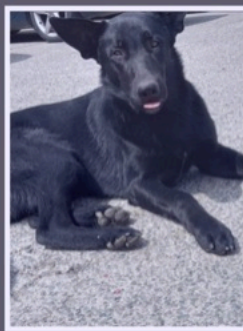
StreetEye Carla visited and took care of things and Jorge made a donation



918 - Bruno

Kate rescued Bruno and adopted him after he repeatedly escaped from his owner and came to her house, seeking refuge. He was not chipped and his "owner" expressed no interest in keeping him. Local people were feeding Bruno and neighbours begged Kate to keep him because he was badly treated.

His health meant that Kate's financial situation deteriorated so she asked us for help getting him snipped and we agreed.



919 - Ipe

Oksana looks after many dogs in and around gypsy camps and came across Ipe living on the streets and being fed by local people working nearby. Apparently, we had already helped his mother some time ago so we asked StreetEye Dineke to visit which she duly did and reported that Ipe was a lovely black German Shepherd about a year old and in good health.

We agreed to help so he did not become an accidental father. 😊



920 - Star

Paulo is an artist from Fuseta. His income comes solely from the work he makes and sells on the street. He lives with Star and takes good care of her. However, due to an oversight, she became pregnant. Paulo was understandably concerned and asked APAR for help; they advised him to request support from StreetLife.

He agreed on a small donation to help with the costs and StreetEye Carla took care of things. 😊



921 - Lili

Amorim lives in the countryside, and as is usual in this area, with a very large yard and several animals. Among them we have 4 year old Lili.

When Lili is in heat, she always ends up getting pregnant, as the dogs all live together. Amorim has a hard time giving away all the puppies and that's why he asked for help to sterilise Lili.

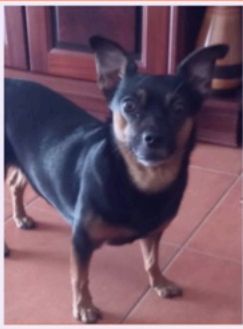
StreetEye Carla visited and we agreed to help.

They covered the costs of vaccinations and heartworm treatment but asked if we could help with her sterilisation before trying to rehome her.

Obviously we said yes!



922 - Luna

Luna is 8 years old and the family were upset about a moment of carelessness that resulted in a pregnancy. They could not afford the sterilisation cost because Luna is a big girl. A friend contacted StreetEye Carla who visited the family and confirmed that Luna was very pregnant. We got her to one of our partner Vets and now, everyone can relax.

Carla also met Luna's father and another unsterilised female so we'll revisit the situation once Luna is fully recovered!



925 - Pantera

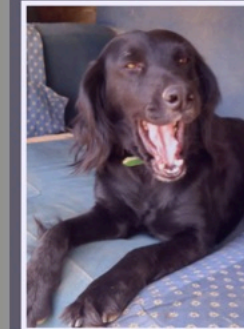

923 - Vinnie

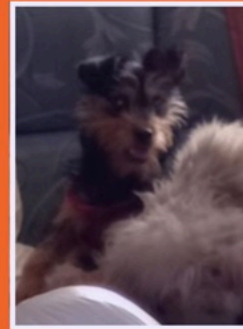

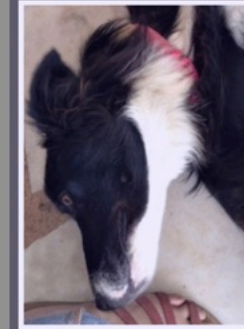
This is Unica and Pantera (No 925) – all taken care of.

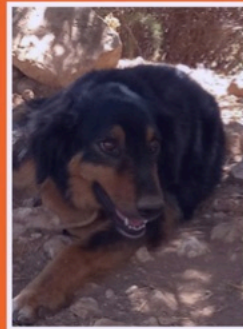


930 - Oreo

She certainly seems relaxed about it all!

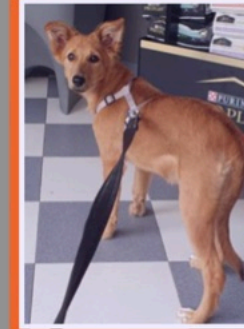


932 - Estrelinha

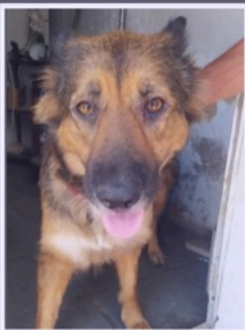
As Shiva's sterilisation was an unexpected, additional expense for Ana Rita, she asked if we could help again and we agreed.





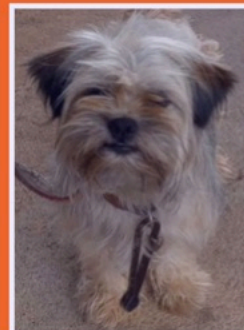
934 - Tita

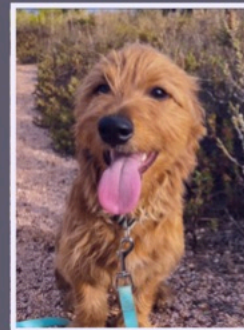
940 - Boris

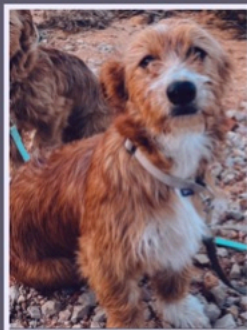
941 - Branquinha

StreetEye Roseane took care of things for us.



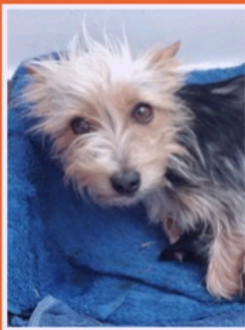
942 - Yoshi

We looked into the situation and with a donation for each dog, we agreed to help.



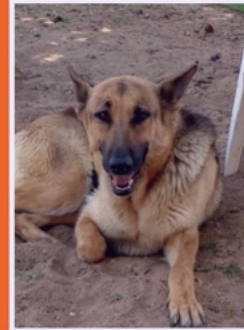
943 - Funky

944 - Belinha

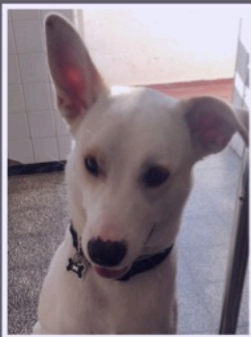
Jose found a very pregnant Belinha (then about 2 years old) on the streets and took her in.

She was concerned about a "like mother – like daughter" situation repeating itself, so StreetEye Carla took care of things again.



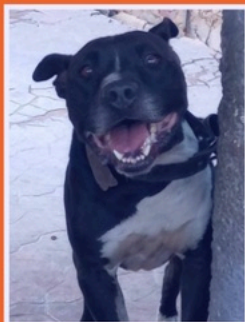


946 - Max

There may be one more for us to sterilise and then we're all done.

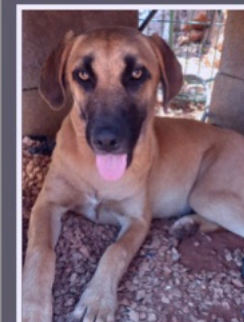

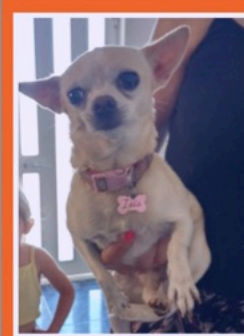
Antonio was upset that his dogs were getting out and he's trying to fix the problem.

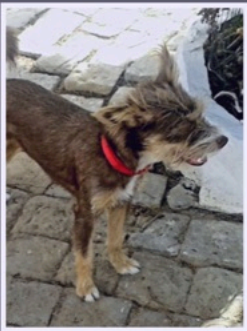


957 - Isis

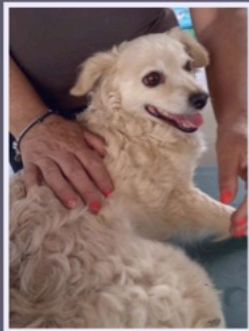
Silvia told her about StreetLife and we agreed to help.

960 - Sky

This is Sky, brother to Nala who we sterilised in July (No 947).

He kept running off and his owners agreed that their place was probably not adequate for keeping dogs.

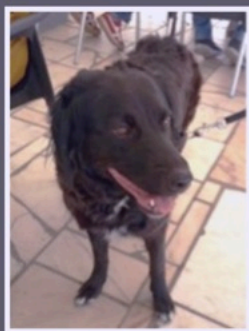
On this basis, they agreed to allow StreetEye Dineke to arrange for his snip and to rehome him.

Gracinda lives in Loulé and has adopted many stray cats and dogs over time. She asked for help with Cuca and we agreed.

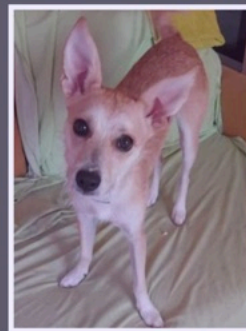

Here we have Gil who lives in Faro with his owner Antónia and a dog named Nina. Sometime ago, we tried to sterilise Nina but she was too old (14 years) and had a heart condition.

Gil came from the APAR shelter and won't now cause any problems for Antónia and Nina.



965 - Iris

Iris is the leader of a pack of three dogs (2 males and 1 female) belonging to Ricardo in Moncarapacho.

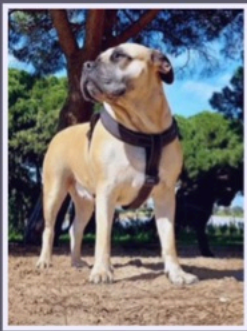
Ricardo didn't want them to inter-breed so StreetEye Carla visited the family and we agreed to sterilise Iris, with a donation from Ricardo.

Nala lives with Tiago and family in Olhão. The first time she got pregnant Tiago ended up with another male dog from the litter. He was keen to sterilise Nala, but wasn't able to afford the total cost as Nala is a big girl!

Meanwhile, with Nala pregnant again, Tiago contacted StreetEye Carla.

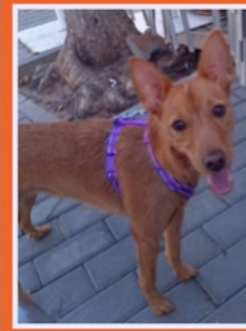
Fortunately, we were able to get Nala into one of our partner Vets quickly and prevented 10 more unwanted puppies. Tiago can relax now!

With a small donation, StreetLife was happy to agree.

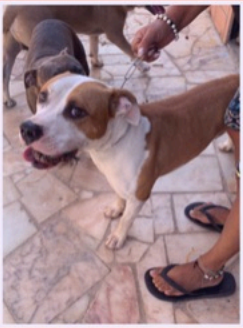




970 - Leo

971 - Ella

Ann and her husband were out walking their two dogs when they heard a dog crying and found little Ella drowning in the cisterna of a deceased neighbour. They managed to rescue her with the help of a friend and took her to a local shelter but they were full. They decided to sort out her health, get her sterilised and put her up for adoption.

StreetEye Dineke visited on behalf of StreetLife to assess the situation and we agreed to help. Lucky escape Ella!



974 - Tommy

StreetEye Dineke found two sweet dogs laying by the side of the road – probably dumped. She took them in... placed posters around the area, did postings on Facebook and Encontra-me but to no avail.

They've both been taken care of now and are up for adoption.

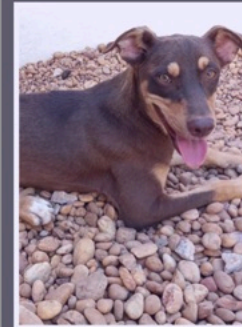


972 - Cindy

So, here we have Laica and Tommy (No 974) – both about 9 months old and probably related, according to the Vet.

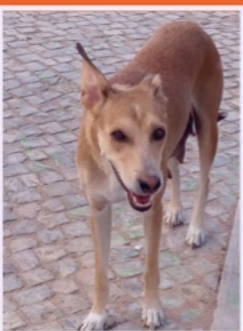
They've both been taken care of now and are up for adoption.

978 - Rambí

Carla lives in an apartment in Olhão with Rambí and Kimi her mother (No 977). Rambí also had a litter earlier in the year and was about to go on heat again.

Kimi has also had a litter (she escapes through the window when on heat and comes back pregnant) and APAR helped with rehoming them.

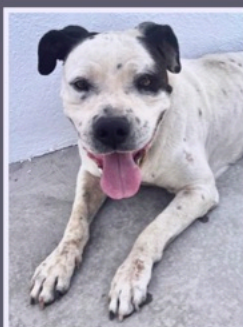
Carla was concerned about this situation continuing, so APAR pointed her in our direction and StreetLife agreed to help.

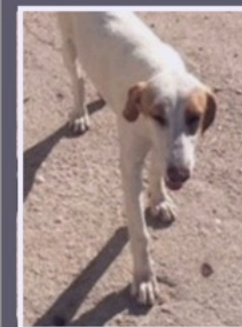
Helena had personally paid for the vaccinations and microchip but couldn't manage the sterilisation alone, so StreetLife agreed to help.

We agreed to help and hope to hear back from Allison some time about how he is and hope that Billy finds a new home soon.

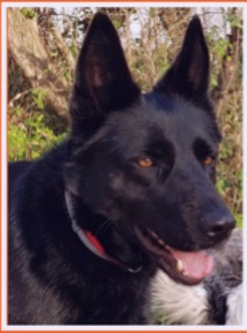


983 - Makie

Carina was upset and asked for help to get Aisha sterilised, so we agreed with a donation towards the costs. We get there eventually!

Lola is 4 years old, and she is a Rafeiro Alentejano. She is a very sweet dog and has never had babies before, as Ana and her husband were always careful.

However, the last time Lola was on heat, it was a very difficult time at the house because Ana's husband had sadly died.

Lola went out into the street and mated. StreetEye Carla swung into action and we got Lola into a partner Vet as soon as possible.

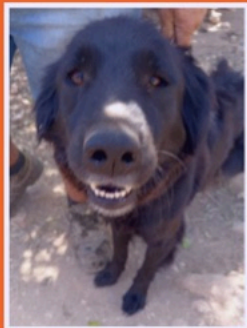


987 - Nina

StreetEye Carla took care of things as usual – well done!

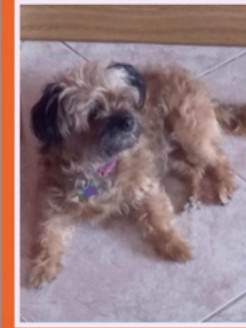


988 - Preta

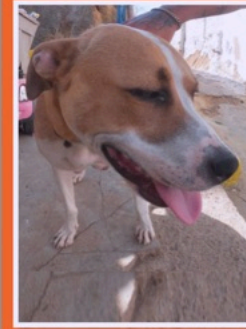

Anabela searched for help because she simply couldn't afford all these dogs and didn't know what to do.

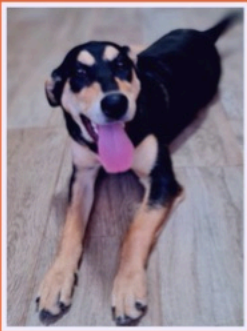
StreetEye Carla got involved and everything was taken care of in good time.

Little Pipoca was abandoned on the streets as a tiny puppy but rescued by Andreia who had just recently lost her own dog.

She had Pipoca checked out by the municipal vet who suggested she be sterilised when old enough. Andreia's financial situation was not good so a neighbour who StreetLife had already helped suggested she contact us which she did.

We were happy to agree to help.

What a beauty Bailey is and so very lucky to be surrounded by love

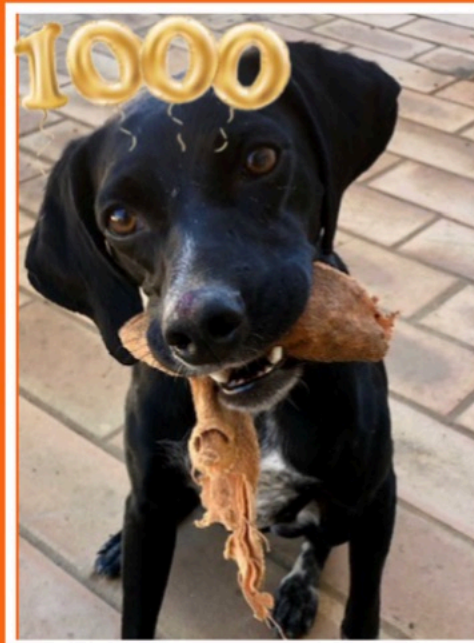


999 - Benny
