Now Lulu is six months old, everyone agreed that it was time to sterilise her as it would benefit her health and protect her against unwanted litters and finally, because Helena also has a male dog.

StreetLife was delighted to help out - it's great to have a happy ending like this, so well done to all involved and sincere thanks to our supporters!

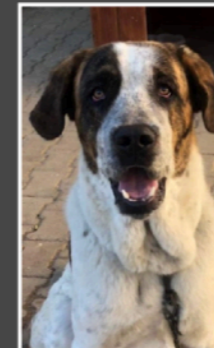

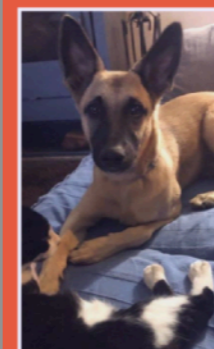

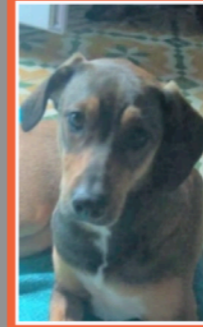


This is 9-month old Archie (rescued with Gaia - No 610, by APAR) Pedro and his wife, who live in Altura decided to give these two pups a home.

They're a bit older now and everyone was concerned that Gaia will become pregnant if Archie isn't sterilised.

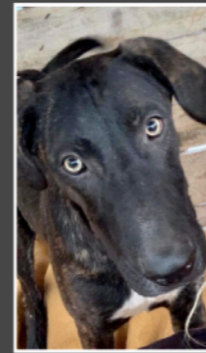
StreetEye Carla got on the case and we agreed to sterilise them both. BE WISE - STERILISE.

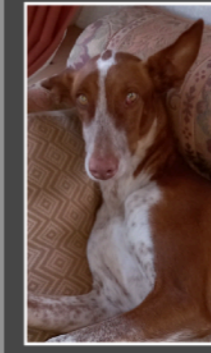
Our friends Treve and Sharron at Cacela Dog Haven asked if we could help with Adam and Dina. Here is Adam, about six months old.

Our friends at Cacela Dog Haven knew about the situation and helped her to contact StreetLife. With a small donation from Sandra, we were happy to help!

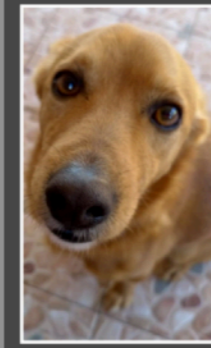
**Luna Cocoa

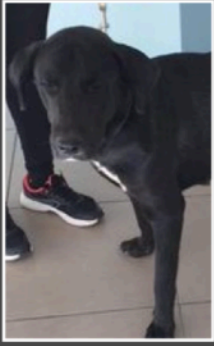

We were happy to oblige!

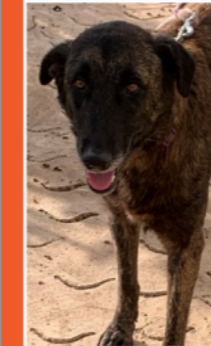
Ariel 621

Oreo 623

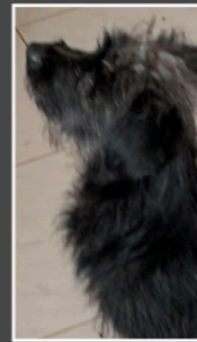

Hopefully – Oreo has quietened down a bit now.

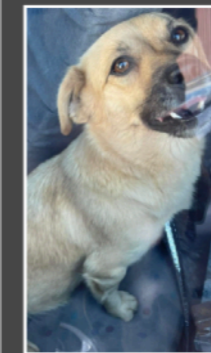
Nené 624

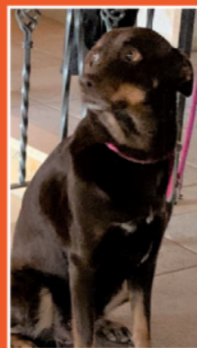

Queenie 629

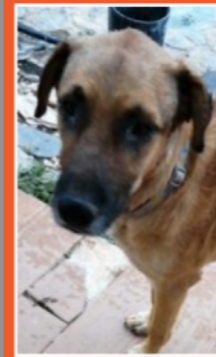

Woody 630

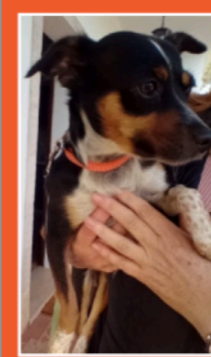

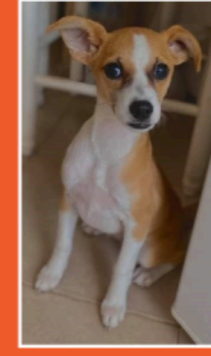


A while ago we sterilised Queenie (No 629) and said the boys were next.

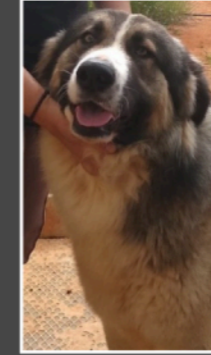
This crazy lady is 4-year old Masha from Moncarapacho.

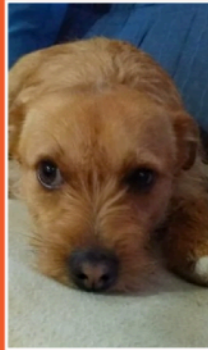

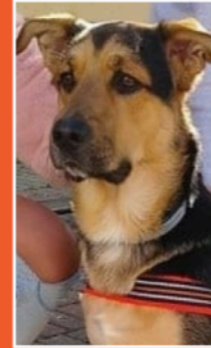

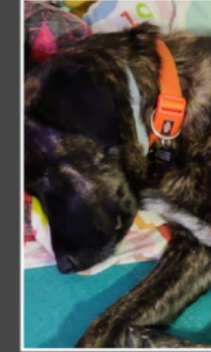
This handsome boy is Zeus, who was adopted from the APAR shelter by João Paulo and his girlfriend when he was too young to be sterilised.

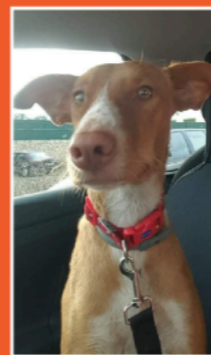

Flocka 645



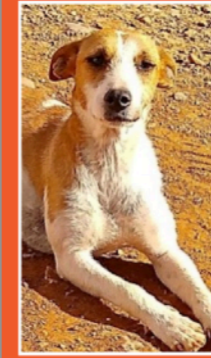
This is young Flocka who was rescued by Cacela Dog haven and then adopted by Joana and her family near Estoi.

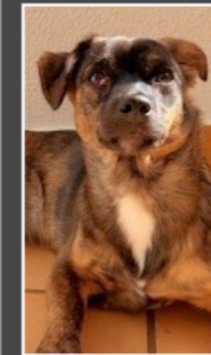

Cookie 651



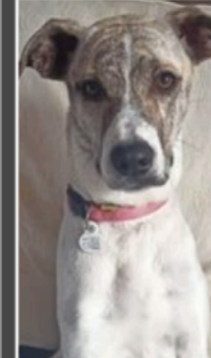

Well done everyone! 😊

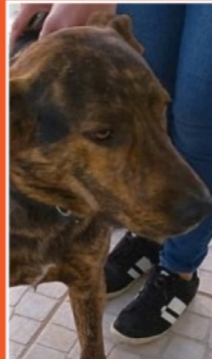
Paco 653

Pardo 654

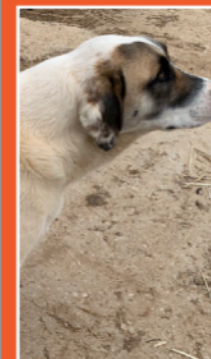

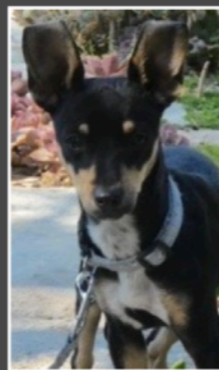


As a result of a clinic in June 2018, we sterilised two of Claudia's dogs. She contacted us recently about Rufia (No 655) and Sasha.

We agreed to help and with a donation from Claudia, everything went well.

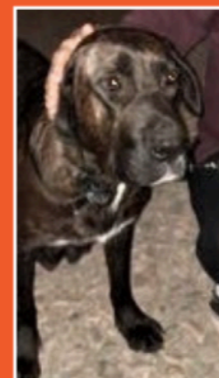

StreetEye Dineke visited Jan and Chica last month to see how they were and explained how it all worked, so little Chica is now OK!

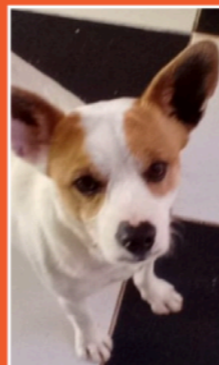
**Kika

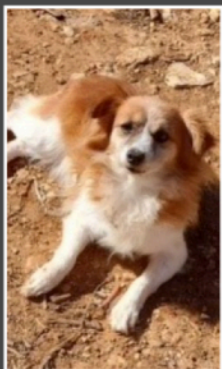


StreetEye Roseane visited Carlos earlier this year, because he has three dogs (two males, one female) and wanted help with sterilisation before any more puppies appeared.

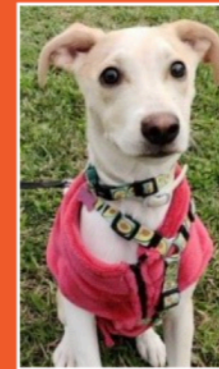

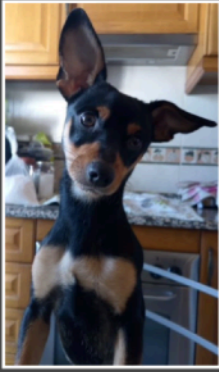
Pucci is an adorable little dog, adopted from APAR by Salomé who likes to help animals and has other dogs and cats.

StreetEye Carla was contacted and we agreed to help.

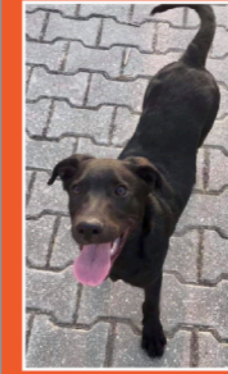

Unfortunately, Maluken then went on heat so we had to wait 30 days but we eventually got her in and all is now well.

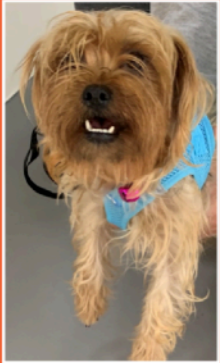
Jupiter 670

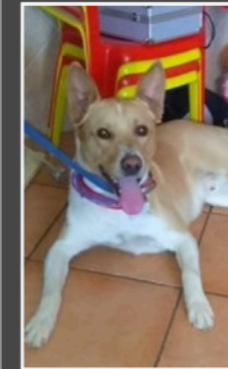


This is a little bundle of energy who didn't want to sit still for the photo..... Just 6 months old, Kira was adopted from APAR.

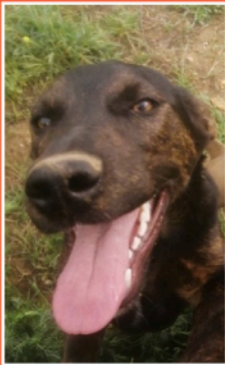

Jumpy 674

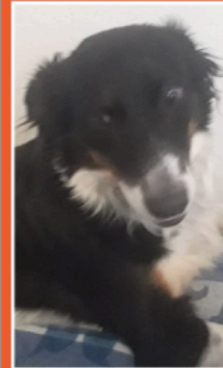


Jumpy is 7 months old and well-named because she is always jumping. She lives with her owner Julio who is concerned because he has a also male pit bull.

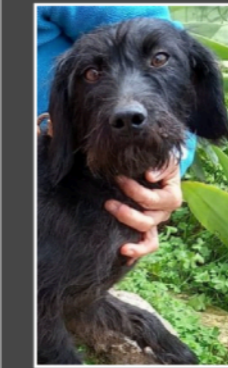


This is little Miny whose owner Ana visited StreetLife at the new art fair in Moncarapacho.

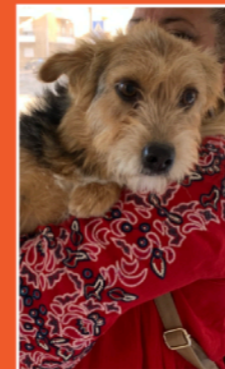

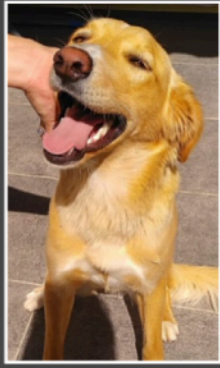
Perdida (1 year old) was found by João, who checked for a microchip and tried to find out if anyone was looking for her. Unable to trace her owner, he decided to keep her.

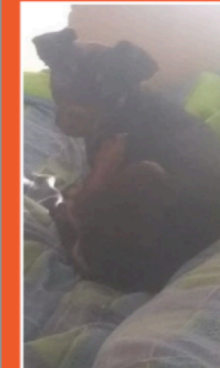

Now Starlet and Mel can enjoy life without fear of getting pregnant!

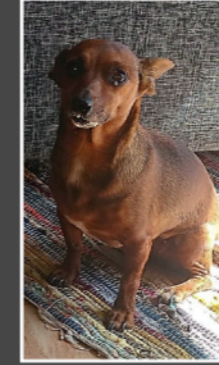

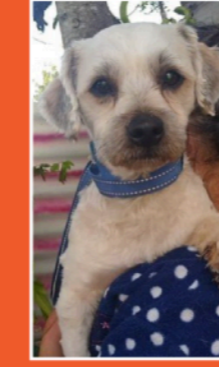


This is little Mel who lives with Leila in Olhão. She wanted to sterilise Mel and asked StreetLife for help, because she is not working at the moment.

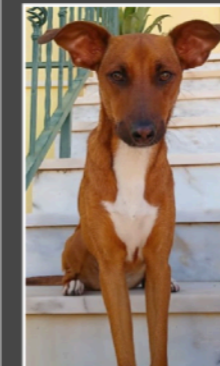


Kiko is small (8 Kilos) and 4 years old. Sadly, he could no longer stay with his family because they did not have the conditions to keep him.

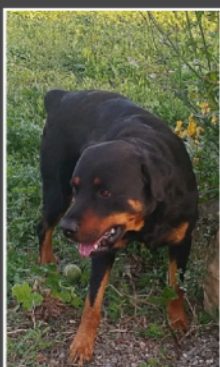
Luna (around 2 months) was found in a garbage bin in Olhao by Sandra who decided to keep her.

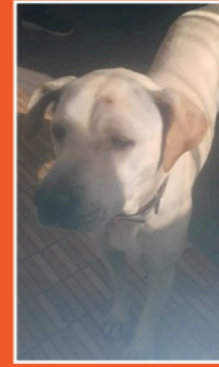
Drago, a big Rottweiler was rescued by Ruben from gypsies when he was a baby.

She asked StreetLife for help and with a donation from the owner, both were sterilized. Good teamwork again!

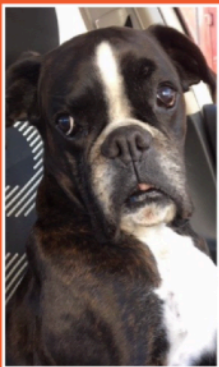

The necessary arrangements were made and Kika will be litter free in the future. Well done Julie! 😊

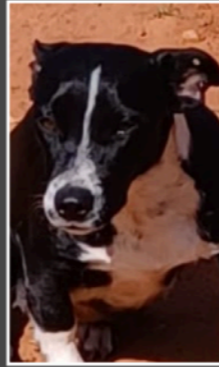
**Lucky

Sterilisation is the only solution, and we agreed to help. We're sure Lucky will find a fabulous new home soon.

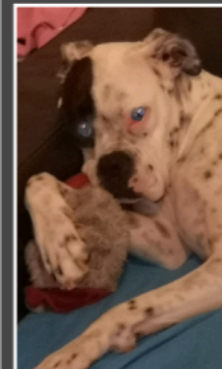
**Menina

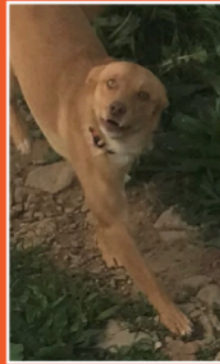

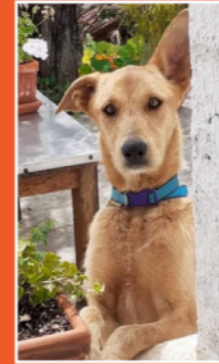

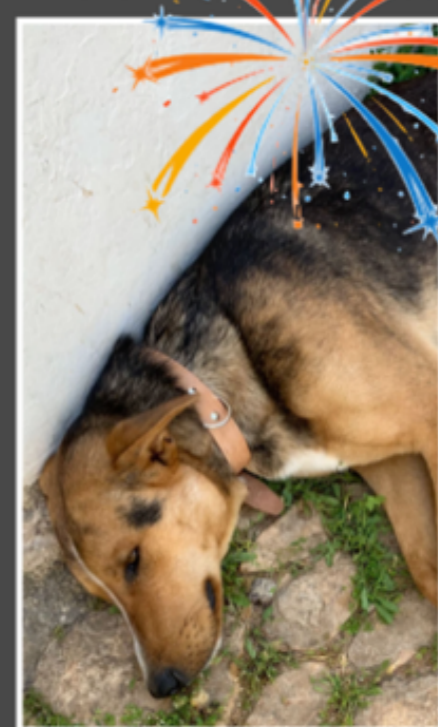
Lucy from A Dog's Life came to talk with us at a fund-raising craft fair in Moncarapacho about Samba, who had been found tied to a tree at barely one year old.
