Happiness all round! 😊

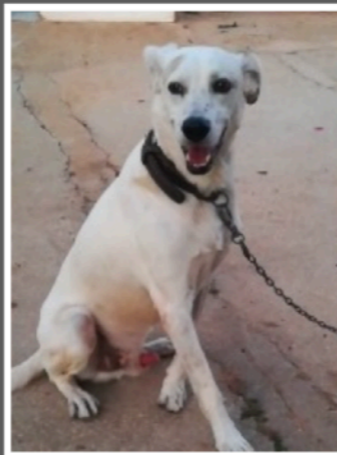


801 - Dama

Hopefully that's it for a while!



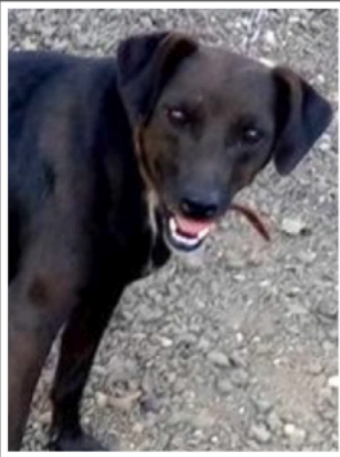
806 - Big Dog

All taken care of! 😊

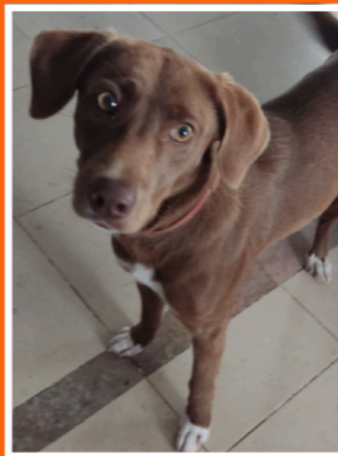


807 - Perrita

Her first heat was a bit of a nightmare for Carla, because Brownie wanted to say "hello" to all the chaps she passed out walking.

Carla decided that sterilisation was the best option so she asked us for help and we agreed. No more "hello big boy" for Brownie!



809 - Pantufa

Lisdalia lives just outside Moncarapacho and has a few dogs that she wanted to sterilise. She also saw our promotion with the Junta de Freguesia and applied for help.

We visited to assess the situation and agreed to help with three of her dogs.

In late 2022, we sterilised the first two of Lisdalia's three dogs (Nos 746 & 760).

We were happy to help. No more heats or infections and most importantly.... no unwanted puppies!

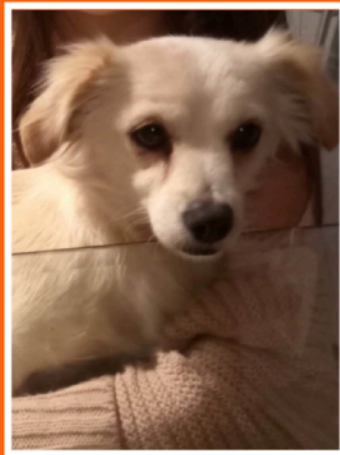


812 - Mel

Not surprisingly, she became pregnant so Rodrigues contacted StreetEye Carla about getting her taken care of.

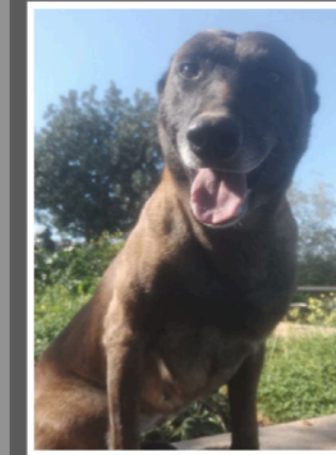
We were happy to oblige.

Cookie was on heat at the time so we had to wait a while (fortunately she managed to avoid a pregnancy) but everything is now taken care of.

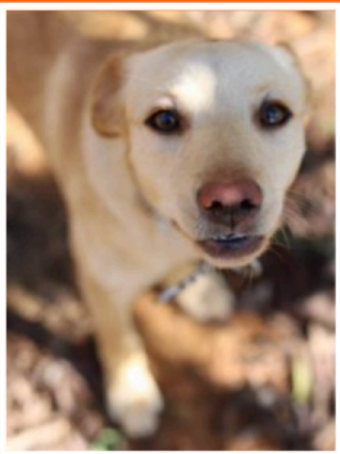


815 - Star

We'll be back for the other female soon!



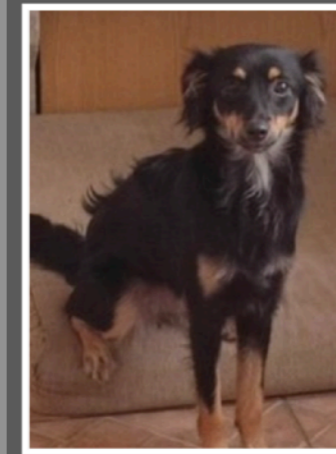
817 - Juliam

Because we don't want him to get into trouble with the local ladies we were happy to help with the "snip" for Juliam.



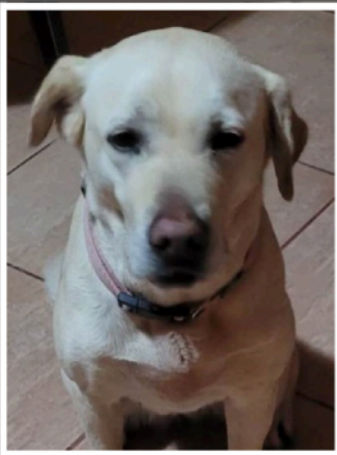
818 - Flora

So, Carla visited to assess the situation and we agreed to help.

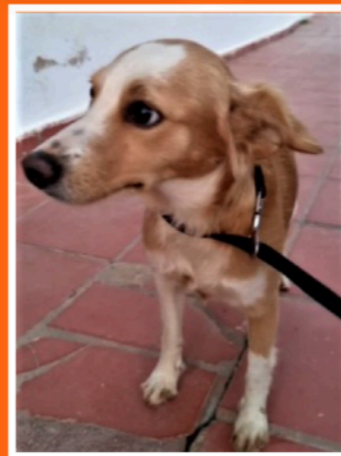




819 - Aura

We agreed to help and everything was taken care of, so no unplanned puppies in that household.

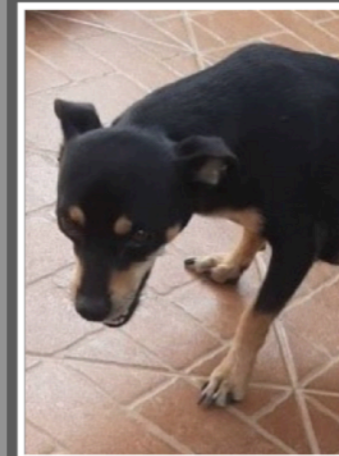


820 - Noa

He was concerned that Thor would cause trouble around the neighbourhood otherwise, and we agreed.



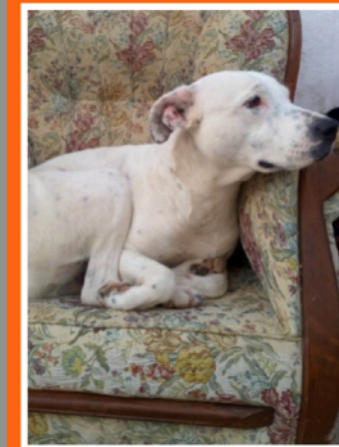
823 - Mel

We were happy to help! 😊



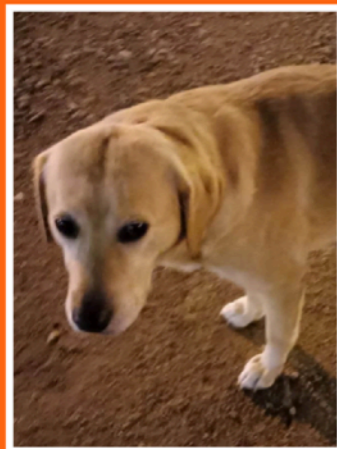
824 - Diva

A dog's life! 😊



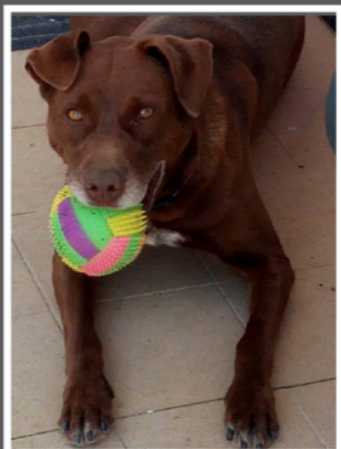
825 - Lua

Fortunately, when we went ahead with the sterilisation, she wasn't pregnant and thankfully, that possibility no longer exists!

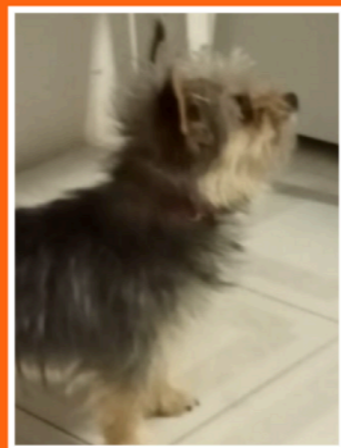


828 - Max

Good thinking!

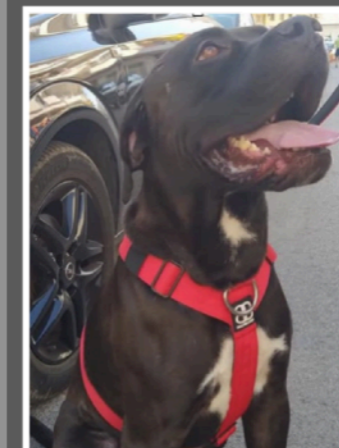
With a young family, Renata could not afford the normal fee for a sterilisation, so with a donation from the, we agreed to help.

Here we have Geovana who is nearly three years old and whose owner does not have access to the internet.

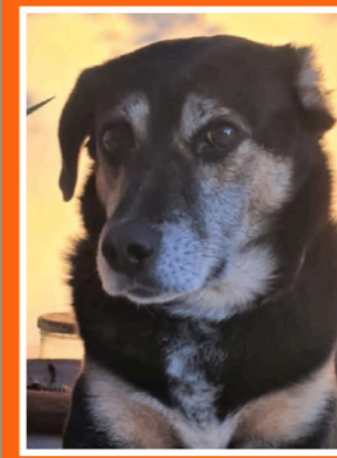
Sonia offered to take care of things and we were happy to help.

A quick "snip" for Rio will help to keep the peace and keep the girlies safe!



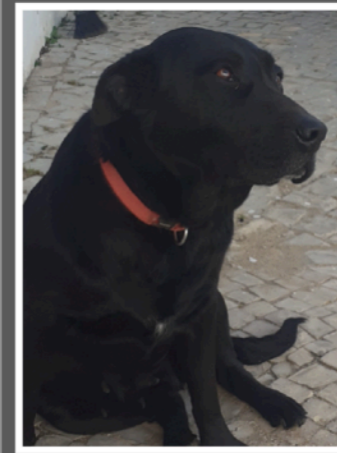
838 - Xana

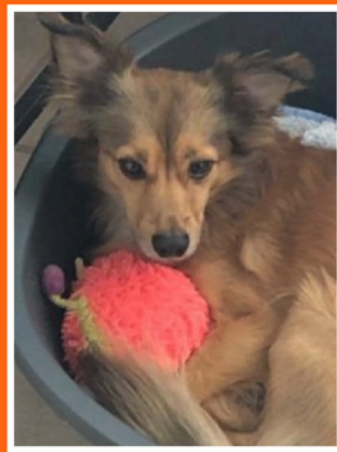


839 - Nina

Let's hope that Ana is able to enjoy some peace and quiet now!

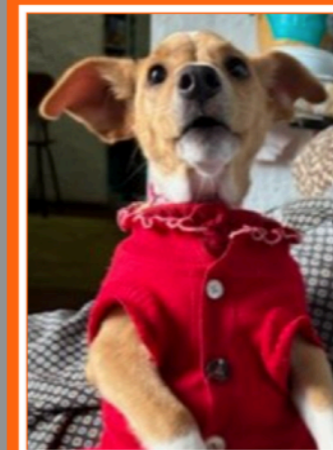


844 - Bany

Dineke visited to assess the situation and we agreed to help, so here is the first little lady – Pipa. Number two coming shortly!

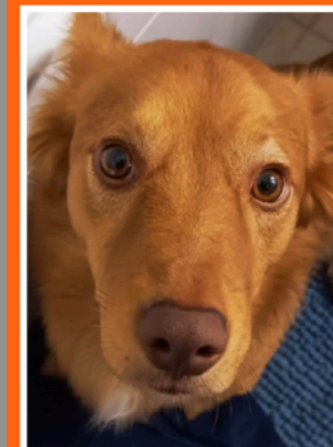


847 - Nemo

Thanks to StreetEye Dineke for helping out as well. Team effort!

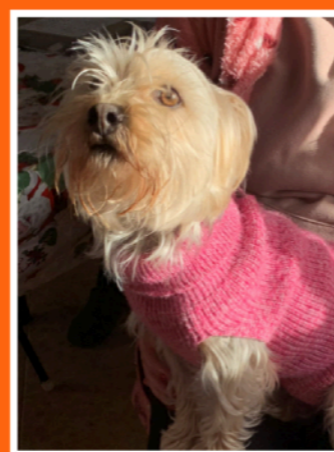


852 - Monty

We visited to assess the situation and agreed to help..... all went well!

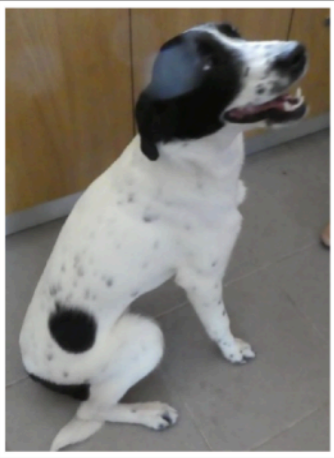


854 - Ritinha

Princesa's owner, Deolinda, has no transport so our good friend Marie from 2ndHandFour Footers agreed to visit her and take care of the logistics for us.

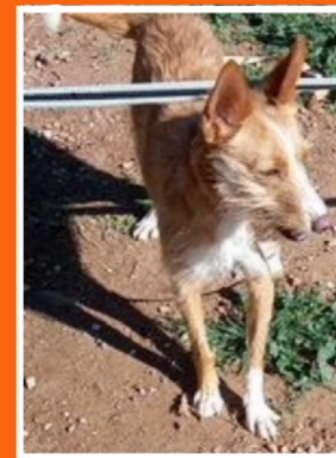


856 - Pandora

Working as a team is good! 😊



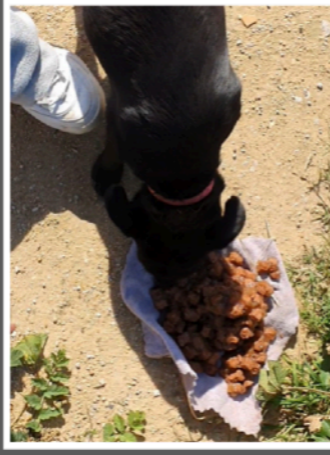
858 - Ladybird

Working as a team is good! 😊

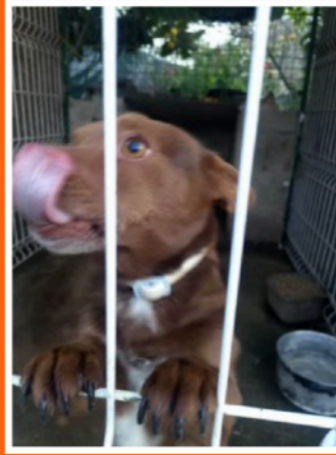


859 - Boneca

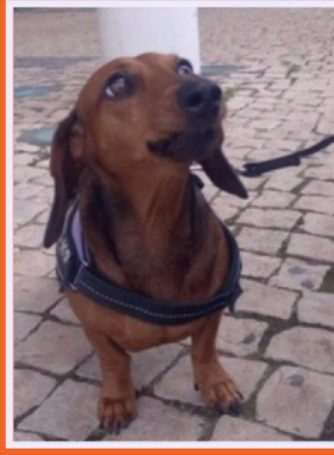

Natalie spoke to us about 2 year old Kayla when we were visiting Lucy at A Dog's Life.

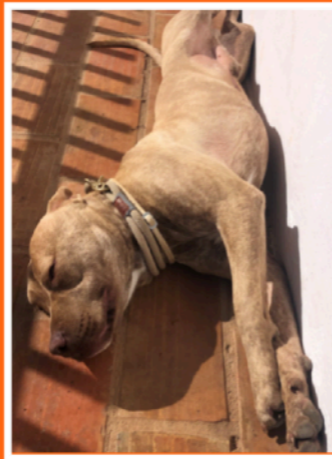
Natalie was fostering Kayla who was found as a stray at St. Miguel near the A22.

"Unofficial" StreetEye Nádia took care of things for us so all is good.



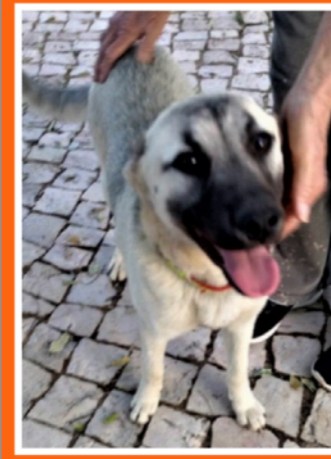
868 - Tofo

APAR spoke with her and said to ask StreetLife for help, as Maria is unable to pay the full cost on her own.

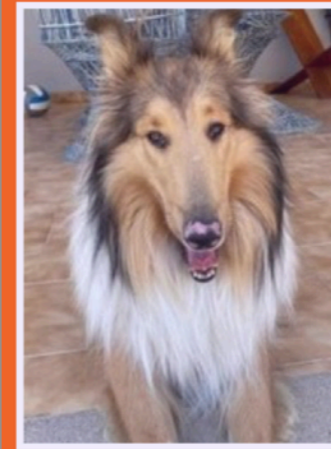
StreetEye Carla visited and we agreed to help.

However, because of Maria's limited income, we agreed to help and Lucy will not have any "unwanted litter" problems now.

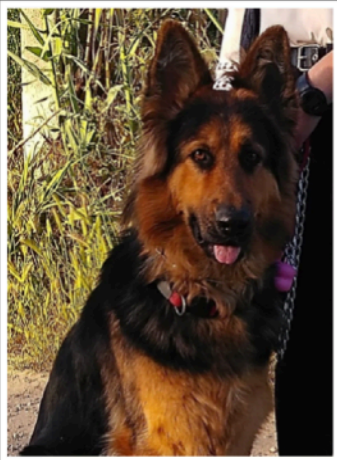


878 - Liberty

Ozzy is a 5 year old small Chinese crested chappie in residence at A Dog's Life shelter.

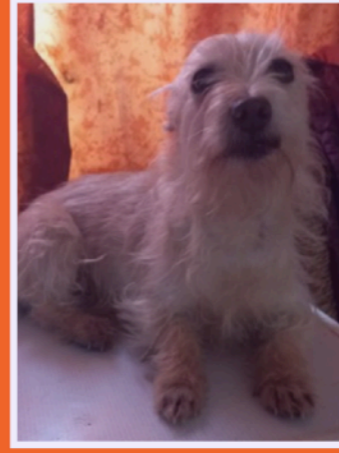
Lucy asked for help with his snip so it's all taken care of now.

We agreed to help to sort out the situation.

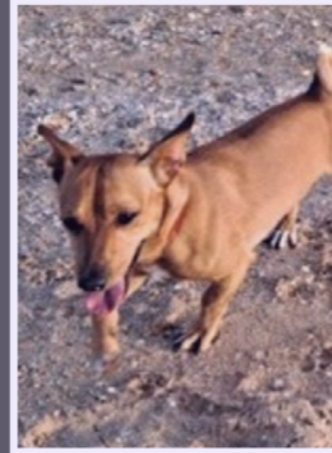
That's what StreetLife is here for!

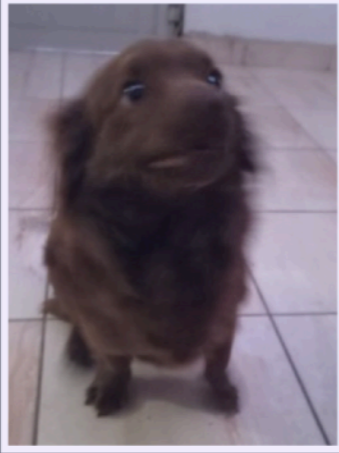

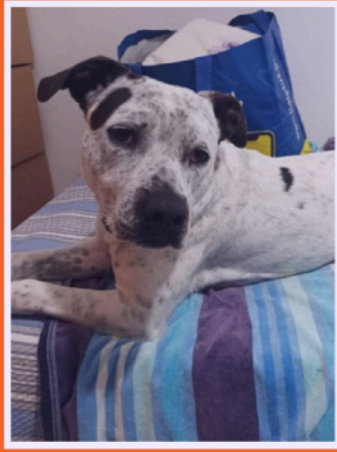

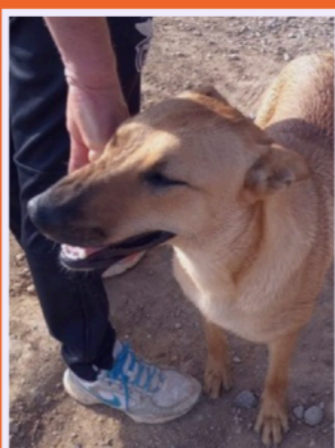
891 - Cissita

No more problems!

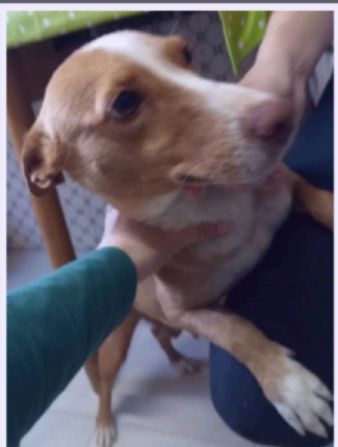


893 - Minie

We were happy to prevent this re-occurrence with the help of StreetEye Carla!

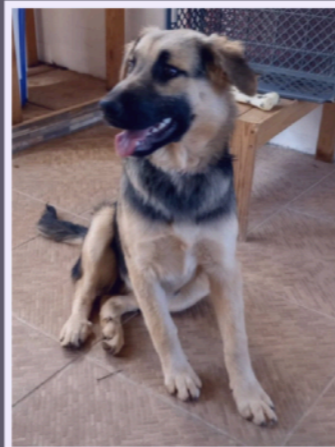


894 - Shay

Ema agreed, so StreetEye Carla took care of things.



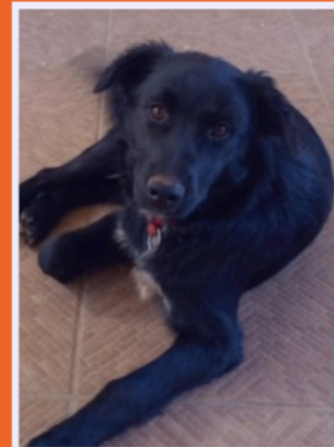
895 - Belle

So here is Belle and the other pup is Xini (No 896).... they now have a new life with Cristina's family.



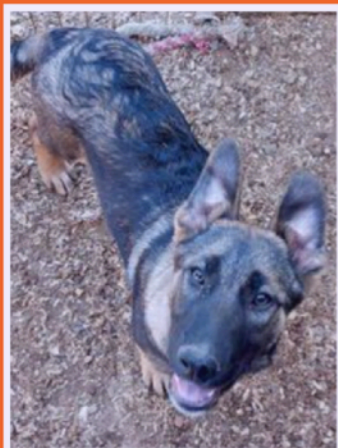
896 - Xini

Peggy is now "safe" from having any unwanted puppies.

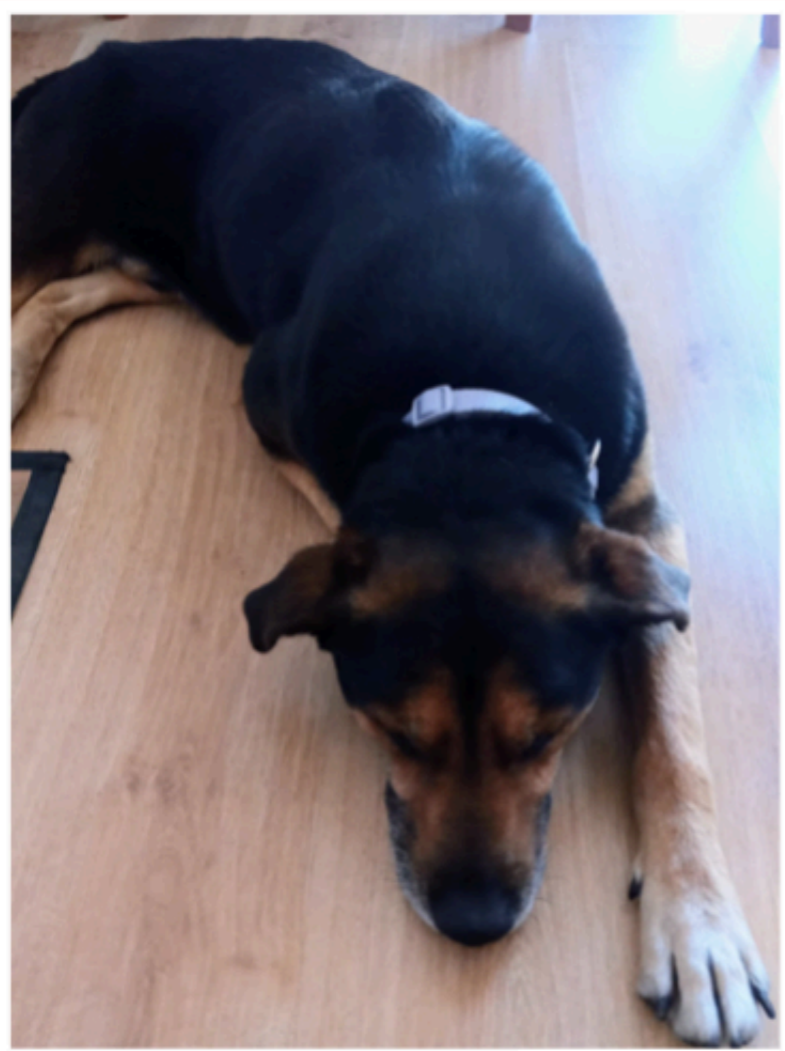


899 - Sky
